- 1. Working together.
- 2. Reading the book and talking about it.
- 3. Working as a team.
- 4. Writing down words, facts, and information from the book and drawing something from the book.
- 5. Focusing on the book instead of talking to other people outside the discussion group.
- 6. Staying on the right page with the discussion group and not reading ahead.
- 7. Knowing what you are talking about from the story.
- 8. Listening carefully to the other people in your group; having one speaker at a time.
- 9. Being respectful and considerate.
- 10. Staying with your discussion group; not wandering around the room.
