1. Working together.
2. Reading the book and talking about it.
3. Working as a team.
4. Writing down words, facts, and information from the book and drawing something from the book.
5. Focusing on the book instead of talking to other people outside the discussion group.
6. Staying on the right page with the discussion group and not reading ahead.
7. Knowing what you are talking about from the story.
8. Listening carefully to the other people in your group; having one speaker at a time.
9. Being respectful and considerate.
10. Staying with your discussion group; not wandering around the room.
