

Charles Whitaker, Ph.D., the lead field content advisor for *Write in the Middle* and a contributing writer for the Web site, is professor of English at Eastern Kentucky University in Richmond, Kentucky where he has taught for 28 years and has been recognized as an ECU Foundation Professor. He has taught writing for more than 30 years, along with graduate courses in composition studies, and has published articles and a textbook on writing. He administered the writing program in his department for ten years; and for the past 17 years he directed two National Writing Project sites—EKU and the Mountain Writing Project, conducted in collaboration with Hazard Community College. Dr. Whitaker has served on the Kentucky Writing Advisory Committee for more than ten years and has worked closely with the Kentucky Department of Education to develop the state's Program of Studies in English/Language Arts, materials used in statewide assessment of writing and statewide professional development in writing instruction. In addition, he consults with school districts and schools throughout Kentucky to improve instruction and test scores in writing. Dr. Whitaker also has served on the faculty at Transylvania University in Lexington, Kentucky.
