Goal:

To understand how cause and effect are represented in the "Daedalus and Icarus" myth
Student Roles: Actors role-playing characters from the myth
Audience: Peers
Situation: Students create scenes to represent events, ideas, and relationships that define and support character traits, motivations, and actions.
Product: Improvised scenes exploring causes and effects occurring in the myth
